## Exhibition Calling Notice - Quarr Abbey, Ryde

**Thurs 11<sup>th</sup> – Tues 16<sup>th</sup> August 2022** daily from 10.30am - 4.30pm

**SUBMISSION FEES:** – Please pay by bank transfer if possible as cheques payable to **Isle of Wight Art Club** incur an individual handing fee at the bank. **New bank details** are on the Submission Form. You may also pay your fees by card, cash or cheque at the Painters' Picnic at Carols on 19<sup>th</sup> July and hand in your forms then.

**£3.00** for each piece of work to be hung, maximum **3** pictures. **£5.00** if your picture is over 1 metre in height or width, only **one** piece permitted and counts as one of your 3 hanging pieces allowed.

**£2.00** for each unframed piece of work in the browser, maximum **3** pictures, (Pastels at own risk.)

**£1.00** for each Miniature to be displayed in the Miniature Display Case (see 'Exhibition Rules and Guidelines 'Miniatures'), maximum of **3** pictures (may be in addition to the above).

**Cards**, no submission charge, any number of designs to be sold at **£2.00** each with a maximum total of **35 cards**. Cards may only be submitted by artists exhibiting pictures in the Exhibition and no extras added during the Exhibition.

**20%** commission from all sales applies (10% of which is held by the Club) and is non negotiable.

## **CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: Thurs 28<sup>th</sup> July 2022**

Please adhere to this date, as once the labels and catalogue have been printed they cannot be changed.

### **HANDING IN WORK**

**Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> August** at Quarr Abbey. Please take your wrapping material away.

Artists with surname A – L between 1pm and 1.30pm. Surnames M – Z between 1.30pm and 2pm.

### **COLLECTING UNSOLD WORK**

**Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> August.** To avoid overcrowding the Gallery while visitors are still trying to view the exhibits, the doors will be locked at the close of the Exhibition at **4.30pm** to allow the Exhibition Committee to remove the remaining paintings and count cards.

**The doors will be unlocked at approx 4.45pm to allow members to collect their work and to check card numbers until 5.30pm. Please do not arrive beforehand. Thank you.**

### **STEWARDING**

To ensure the smooth running of the exhibition and for the safety and security of the work exhibited, it is essential we have **two** stewards on duty throughout the opening times. **All members who exhibit are required to volunteer for a period of stewarding during the course of the exhibition.** The stewarding periods are morning **10.30am-1.30pm**; afternoon **1.30pm-4.30pm** daily. Please give at least **two dates** when you are available, more if possible to enable the Exhibition to remain open, indicating a first choice if you have one on the submission form. Separate stewarding notes covering duties, venue security and making a sale will be made available to Stewards.
